1. Carmarthenshire County Council commissioned an independent review of services for disabled children in 2016.

The review focussed on a number of areas of operation of services for disabled children and undertook detailed consultation with a sample of 25 families, selected randomly, as well as staff and other stakeholders. The review found that our overall organisation and deployment of resources was not as effective as it ought to be.

Evidence did emerge to support the view that there appeared to be a mismatch of resources relative to need, as well as a mismatch between demand and supply in

some areas of service. There was also a lack of transparency as to how services were allocated.

The review recommended:

'Personalisation of services needs to be actively promoted through much greater use of direct payments underpinned by a formal Resource Allocation System (RAS) to ensure better consistency and equity in funding'

Further work was undertaken including detailed audits to developed a Resource Allocation System which will help to ensure that our services are allocated equitably and transparently.

This proposal is to implement a RAS this approach for Children and extend the approach to include adults, potentially across West Wales. This will ensure that there is a consistent approach regardless of age and will also assist in managing the market place and personalized commissioning.

This will meet the following aims of the West Wales Care Partnership:
